Mobile Email

With Mobile Email you can send and receive emails using your phone.

Setting up Mobile Email

- Your mobile email address is your mobile number followed by **@t-mobile.uk.net** e.g. **07956201099@t-mobile.uk.net**
Visit **www.t-mobile.co.uk/mobile-email** to change your mobile email address
- Send all your Mobile Email texts to **191**

Sending an email

- Type the email address, followed by #, and your message e.g. **robbie.thompson@t-mobile.uk.net# Robbie, I'll be there on time**
- To include a title insert **##title#** after the email address e.g. **robbie.thompson@t-mobile.uk.net##meeting# Robbie, I'll be there on time**
- Send to **191**

Receiving an email

- A text will notify you of an email in your account
- Text notifications are limited to 160 characters
- Visit **www.t-mobile.co.uk/mobile-email** to receive an email notification up to 9 texts in length

Replying to an email

- Type your reply and send to **191**

Storing an email

- Your Mobile Emails will be automatically forwarded to a central mailbox of your choice e.g. **robbie.thompson6@hotmail.net**
- Manage your account notifications by visiting **www.t-mobile.co.uk/mobile-email**

Charges

Standard text message rates apply for sending and receiving mobile emails.

Fax Messaging

Fax Messaging lets you receive faxes on your phone and print them at any fax machine.

Setting up a primary printing destination

- This is a designated fax machine where you most often send your faxes to print
- Access voicemail as normal and press **2** followed by **3** then **1** to set up your primary printing destination

Setting up autoprint

- This automatically sends new faxes to be printed at a preferred fax machine and stores them in your voicemail
- Access your voicemail and press **2** followed by **3** then **2** to turn autoprint off and on

Receiving a fax message

- The sender dials your mobile number from the fax machine and sends as normal
- Once the fax has arrived, the voicemail icon will show on your phone's display

Printing a fax message

- Access your voicemail then select option **2** to print your faxes
- Select option **1** to send the fax to your primary printing destination or option **2** for an alternative destination

Calling from a fax machine

- Access your faxes from a machine by calling your mobile number and then pressing the # key. Enter your PIN and press **33** to print your faxes
